I. GENERAL INFORMATION

II. PARTICIPANTS

1. Participants must actively practice traditional Karate-Do and be able to compete within the categories outlined in this document in accordance with WTKU Competition Rules.
2. The number of participating athletes/teams from any given country is unlimited.
3. In case of insufficient number of contestants for a particular category (minimum is 8 athletes in category) the corresponding category shall be merged with another category of similar age or grade.
4. Coaches are responsible for their respective team members and must be able to present a corresponding valid international insurance for each team member.
5. KUMITE A, B, C, D athletes are NOT obliged to have mouth (teeth) guards, breast-protection for women, groin protector for men. Athletes **have to control** distance. **Any contact will be strictly penalized by hansoku.**



III. CATEGORIES

KATA

FLAG SYSTEM JUDGING: Performed in **pairs** by flag-system judging (two athletes perform kata given by the main judge at the same time). Main judge announces any HEIAN KATA NAME, but not higher than the lowest rank of athlete on tatami (kyu or Dan).

EXAMPLE: 8th kyu athlete competes with 7th kyu athlete → judge is ought to announce Heian Shodan KATA, not higher.

POINT SCORING SYSTEM JUDGING: Athletes perform kata one by one. Order of participants is determined by point scoring. The higher the score, the higher the athlete's placement.

IV. APPLICATIONS & REGISTRATION

A. Registration

2. Details of all athletes including respective competing categories.
3. **Deadline!!!** All registrations must be done **by NOVEMBER 25th.**

- Any application sent after the deadline above shall still be processed, however with double athlete participation fees applied.

Athletes

50 EUR per athlete (single fee per athlete. Athlete can participate in all respective individual categories).

20 EUR per team

Coaches

One official coach per 10 athletes from 1 team is free of charge.

For each additional coach the respective national delegation is obliged to pay 50 EUR registration.

Only registered coaches shall be allowed on the competition floor.

Photographer

One photographer per team is free of charge.

Extra photographer will be charged for 50 EUR.

Only registered photographer shall be allowed on the competition floor.
